## The Architectural Team receives Gold Award from National Association of Home Builders' 50+ Housing Council

**Chelsea, MA,** June 2, 2008 – The Architectural Team's design of Whaler's Place Apartments in New Bedford, MA was recently honored with a Gold Award in the Best of 50+ Housing Awards Competition sponsored by the National Association of Home Builders' (NAHB) 50+ Housing Council. Whaler's Place was recognized in the in "Renovated Housing: Overall Project – Service Enriched" category at an awards gala held in New Orleans. The awards competition recognizes excellence in design, development and marketing for the senior residential market.

The jury panel, comprised of senior living industry experts from the development, architecture, and marketing fields, cited Whaler's Place as "an excellent example of the reuse of an abandoned historic industrial building" and "showed sensitive treatment to scale and use of light. The common areas were rich in color and the use of materials created residentially inviting spaces."

Whaler's Place was one of 36 senior housing design award winners selected from among 300 submissions and was featured in the exhibit hall during the 2008 50+Housing Symposium in New Orleans. The project will also be displayed at the 2009 NAHB International Builder's Show in Las Vegas.

The Architectural Team designed the conversion of the Whitman Mill No. 1 into a 75-unit affordable residential community for active adults aged 55 years and older for Winn Development of Boston. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the 120,000 square foot former cotton textile mill building was constructed in 1895 and employed 1,750 people during its business peak.
