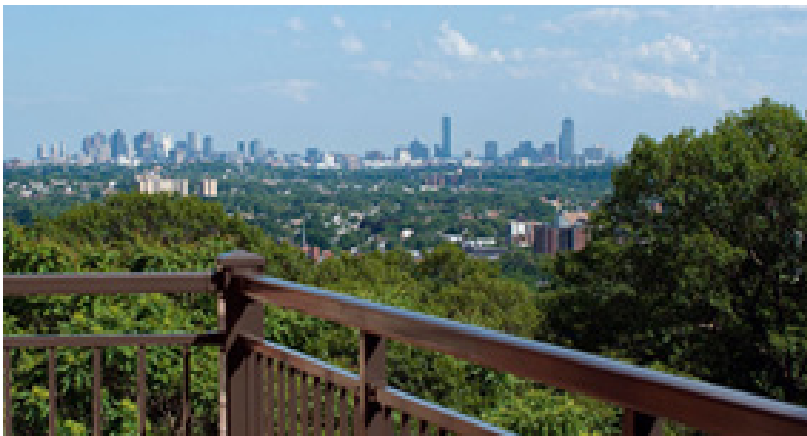




Take a Look at Arlington's Newest Neighborhood

So much happening this fall! Like the opening of Arlington 360, a mixed-use development full of for-sale townhouses and for-rent apartments, built on the ruins of an old hospital campus.

Designed by The Architectural Team and co-developed by the Jefferson Apartment Group and Upton & Partners, Arlington 360 is meant to have a neighborhood feel about it (and the website certainly stresses its proximity to nearby existing neighborhoods like downtown Arlington). There are 12 townhouses; 164 apartments; and amenities like parkland, a playground and a pool, all designed, in the words of a rep from The Architectural Team, to bring "new life to the silent property."

Yes, yes, but what about the prices?! Studio apartments start at \$1,975; one-bedrooms at \$2,140; two-bedrooms at \$2,650; and three-bedrooms at \$3,500. A 2-BR, 2.5-BA, 2,090-square-foot townhouse is asking \$644,000.
